Description of course:	<p>An introduction to no less than eight popular rhythms and melodies from around the world, styles including Calypso, Bossa Nova, Latin American, Egyptian and Greek. We will be listening to and exploring rhythms and techniques used to give each style of music its unique sound.</p> <p>Percussion instruments will be used to perform these rhythms and pupils will have the opportunity to compose and perform their own piece by the end of the session, picking a particular style that they have learnt about.
