Description of course:	<p>Are you interested in robotics? Would you like to be able to program a robot using the latest Lego Mindstorms EV3 robotics system? Would you like to learn how to use touch, light and gyro sensors to control the actions of the robot? Yes? Then come along to our programming workshop to see how it's done, have some fun and show what you can do!</p> <p>Students will work in groups to learn the basics of programming a Lego Mindstorms EV3 Robot.</p> <p>During the session they will learn through a series of activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How to control motors to drive the robot using time or distance measurements</li> <li>• How to turn the robot with the aid of a gyro sensor</li> <li>• How to use touch and light sensors to further control the actions of the robot</li> </ul> <p>Using the skills learned, the students will undertake a simple challenge between the groups.</p> <p>Time permitting, there may be the opportunity to see demonstrations of other examples of robotics based on the same system.</p>
